It's easy, cheaper and fun!

Easy

Fly to Copenhagen and avoid a long bus journey

The UK units are flying in to Copenhagen on 25th July and this is likely to use all of the “group booking” capacity available to the contingent. This will mean any IST travel organised by the UK contingent will probably be via Stockholm or other airports and will involve a long bus journey to the Jamboree site (return flights to the UK will hopefully be from Copenhagen).

However, the contingent will not be using any Easyjet flights and all the other airlines/flights will accept non-group bookings i.e. IST bookings.

There's help at the other end

The Jamboree Organisers will transport you from the “points of entry” below to the Jamboree on 25th July and back to one of the locations on 8th August

Points of entry:

- Copenhagen airport
- Malmo airport
- Kristianstad Rail Station

Cheaper

Flying

- Block booking flights is expensive. Booking single seats (or a small number of seats) is likely to be much cheaper, particularly if you book early.
- The UK Units are not using Easyjet. Easyjet fly to Copenhagen from Gatwick, Stanstead and Manchester.
- There are direct flights to Copenhagen from:
 - o Aberdeen, Glasgow, Edinburgh, Newcastle, Manchester, Birmingham, Heathrow
- There are indirect flights to Copenhagen from many UK Regional airports.

Ferries

There are many ferry crossings across the North Sea/English Channel every day.

Sharing a car will keep the cost lower and you may be able to take more baggage than if you fly.

If you travel as a foot passenger, bus or rail travel to Copenhagen is possible – use google to look for options from the European ferry port.
