

## IST Money Matters – The Options

Let's face it, we're all adults. We are keen to recognise this by providing all UK members of the IST for Sweden as much flexibility as we can. For some, Sweden will not seem like the other side of the world and many people will already be thinking up wacky and wonderful ways to get to the Jamboree. If this is you, we will not stand in your way. Others will not have the time or the experience to arrange transport for themselves. Again, we can help you out.

The Contingent team have developed the following two UK IST options. Where they are known, the costs associated with each are given here, along with the payment schedule. The confirmed inclusive fee of £1350 will not rise. However, dates and other details are subject to change. Further details will be given at or before the selection events in January and February 2010.

### One key point to note!

No decision about these options is needed until after selection. You will be asked to express a non-binding preference, but this is to help with our planning only. It is not a commitment and will not effect your selection in any way.

## Option A – Inclusive of Transport (£1350)

Option A is for those not wishing to arrange their own transport. This option will provide peace of mind and ease of travel. We will arrange return plane tickets from a regional UK domestic or international airport to Copenhagen and return transfers to the Jamboree. However, the dates and times of travel will be restricted and we will not be able to negotiate on them.

### Expected Dates of Travel:

- 23<sup>rd</sup> July 2011: Leave the UK, Transfer to the World Scout Jamboree
- 8<sup>th</sup> August 2011: Leave the World Scout Jamboree, return to the original UK airport.

These dates and details are subject to change, but travel is unlikely to happen before 23<sup>rd</sup> July.

### Included in Option A:

- Transportation from a local UK domestic or international airport to Copenhagen
- Transfers to the 22<sup>nd</sup> World Scout Jamboree
- World Scout Jamboree Event Fee entitling an individual to attend the Jamboree as a member of the International Service Team.
- Return flights and transfers to the original UK airport
- Travel insurance for the duration of the event
- The UK IST kit package
- Attendance at the all adults preparation event in the UK in 2011

## Option B – Under Your Own Steam (Price TBC)

For many, travelling to Sweden will be a project in itself. Option B allows IST members the flexibility to pay a lower fee and arrive at one of three Jamboree entrance points under their own steam. They will need to arrive at some point on 25<sup>th</sup> July and leave on 8<sup>th</sup> August 2011. Travel is the responsibility of individuals.

### Jamboree Entry and Departure Points:

- Copenhagen Airport
- Kristianstad Railway Station
- Jamboree check in area, near the site

### Dates of Travel:

- 25<sup>th</sup> July 2011: Arrive at Jamboree point of entry
- 8<sup>th</sup> August 2011: Leave from Jamboree point of departure

### Included in Option B:

- World Scout Jamboree Event Fee entitling an individual to attend the Jamboree as a member of the International service team.
- Travel insurance for the duration of the event
- The UK IST kit package
- Attendance at the all adults preparation event in the UK in 2011

## IST Payment Schedule

The following table outlines the schedule of payment for IST members. As the fee for Option B has yet to be determined, the schedule indicates payments as a percentage of the total to approximately mirror the schedule for Option A.

Details of how to pay will be communicated following selection.

## What if people drop out?

If individuals withdraw from the IST, the following refund policy shall apply in all cases.

- The first instalment (deposit) is non-refundable
- Cancellations which occur on or before 31<sup>st</sup> August 2010 will be subject to a 35% refund of the amount paid to date (minus the first instalment of £100 per head).
- Cancellations which occur after 31<sup>st</sup> August 2010 and on or before 31<sup>st</sup> December 2010 will be subject to a 20% refund of the amount paid to date (minus the first instalment of £100 per head).
- Cancellations made on or after 1<sup>st</sup> January 2011 will not be subject to any refund.

N.B. Some refunds may not be paid until after the Jamboree.

## Late Payment

In respect of any fees outstanding and due for more than one month, The Scout Association reserves the right to charge an additional fee of 5% of the amount outstanding.

The information and guidance provided here has been carefully considered, so that the management of the Jamboree project runs as smoothly and problem free as possible. The payment schedule and refund policy are based on the need to provide outgoing payments to the Jamboree organisers, travel companies, kit suppliers and others.
